

Safety Procedure for Visitors to West Bradford Golf Club

The following safety procedures are currently in place at West Bradford Golf Club from Mon 18th May until further notice. These procedures have been implemented to protect all of our members, visitors and our members of staff. Procedures will likely change in the future as and when the situation changes.

Please observe the governments social distancing guidelines of 2metres at all times – including when you are out on the golf course.

Whilst West Bradford Golf Club has implemented the following procedures to protect you, we are also relying on visitors to the golf course to use common sense in situations that are not explicitly covered – every person is in charge of their own health and safety.

Booking a Round

- Visitors will be able to book their tee times either using our online booking system via our website or by calling the Pro Shop.
- Visitors must either play solo or in 2-balls.
- Places on the tee sheet for midweek Sunday golf will open for visitor bookings the day prior
 ie: Thursdays tee sheet will open on Wednesday morning.
- Once you have booked a tee time online, please call the Pro Shop on 01274 542 767 ext 1 to pay by card.

Before Your Round

- Please arrive at the golf club no earlier than 20 mins before your tee off time.
- The Clubhouse facilities, including the Clubhouse bar and restaurant, remain closed for now.
- The Pro Shop will be open to visitors but the front door to the Pro Shop from the car park will remain closed – please walk around the building and use the Pro Shop door behind the first tee.
- Only two people are permitted inside the Pro Shop at any one time.
- Hire trolleys are not available at present, but visitors are free to bring their own trolleys.
- We recommend that you carry Antibacterial liquid or wipes in your golf bag.
- Aim to arrive at the first tee just as the pair before you are teeing off ie: if your tee time is 13.00, arrive at the first tee at 12.50.
- Practice facilities remain closed for now, however visitors are permitted to use the practice
 green, two at a time, during the ten minute window between the pair before you teeing off
 and your tee off time.



During Your Round

- Please observe a 2metre social distancing rule at all times whilst on the golf course.
- The hole cups on each green have been turned upside down hole so that they are level with the putting surface therefore you should only need to touch your own ball and not the cup or the flag after putting out.
- Please use the heel of one of your golf clubs to strike any fairway bells in order to notify the group behind that you are clear do not touch the bell itself.
- Please do not touch or remove the pin flags leave them in the hole at all times.
- All bunkers are classed as GUR and rakes have been removed if you land in a bunker please lift your ball out and drop it nearby within one golf clubs length, but not nearer the hole.
- The Warren Halfway House will remain closed for now.
