

Now onto the golfing tip of the week.

Hole 6 – On this long par 5, the tight tee shot lends itself more to accuracy than distance! With trouble right and left, having to chip out for your second will inevitably lead to a bogey or worse. The second shot or layup is just as important. This viciously sloping left to right fairway will always feed the ball to the right, but don't overcook it, as missing left will lead to an almost impossible up and down. Always try to leave yourself an uphill put for par or birdy.
