In my humble opinion, this is the trickiest tee shot at West Bradford. Anything leaked right off the tee will leave you totally blocked out, and with OB down the left, the landing area appears very narrow from the tee. Trust your shape. A well struck shot will find the downslope where the Fairway widens, but forsaking distance for accuracy and leaving a full or longer shot into the green maybe the best plan here. The hole is relatively short, leaving the green very reachable in two. Good luck!
