## Handicaps & Competitions

### General Play Scorecards

The rules for General Play scorecards were issued recently, but we have made a few amendments, particularly regarding submitting a physical scorecard and Markers (Attesters) Please see the revised rules below.

- Register your intent to submit a General Play score BEFORE you tee-off, preferably via the MyEG App, or alternatively via ClubV1 in the Pro Shop
- Play from the Yellow Tees for Men and Red Tees for Ladies
- Play with at least one other person who acts as the Marker (Attester)
- The Marker must hold a WHS Handicap Index and be acceptable to the Handicap Committee
- The Marker must complete a physical scorecard to enable them to compare and check the Players score after the round, before they Attest the score
- The Marker must only verify the hole scores they witnessed
- Along with the MyEG app entry, the physical signed and attested scorecard should be also be submitted
- Where the Marker is also returning a score for handicap, they should enter their own score in the marker's column of the scorecard

- Place the completed scorecard in the box in the Gents locker room. For Ladies, in the box in the 19th
- ALL scores must be returned promptly after play via the MyEG app (or ClubV1)
- Any score not submitted on the day of play will attract an appropriate Penalty score.
- Follow the Rules of Golf and hole out every putt
- Ensure the round is in accordance with Rules of Handicapping

### **Entering A No Score Hole In A Stableford Competition**

If you are not able to score any points on a particular hole in a Stableford competition, rather than entering 0 for the score, it is better if you play the hole out if possible and enter the actual score.

If this is not possible because you maybe went out of bounds and did not play another ball, then please enter a 0 for the score and then select PLAYED HOLE BUT DID NOT SCORE. Please do not select HOLE NOT PLAYED.

Cards to be placed in the appropriate Division slot in the box in the 19th

Division 1 = Playing Handicap 12 and below

Division 2 = Playing Handicap 13 to 18

Division 3 = Playing Handicap 19 and above
